They approved 8 organizations at their last meeting. They approved 2 senator special project. Senate exec approved one of the groups because it was time sensitive.

c. Operations & Evaluations- Chair Kamryn Stewart

Kamryn went over everything they did last semester.

They started working on the legislation. They are creating different codes to consolidate all of the acts they have into one of the various codes they have created.
